- Strong technical understanding of electrical components, assemblies, controls, and industrial systems used in engineered equipment manufacturing

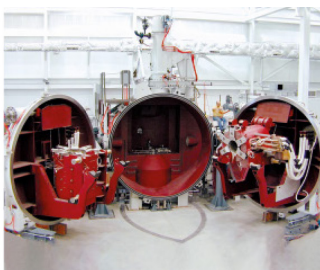
- Must be able to read, interpret, and understand electrical schematics, wiring diagrams, technical drawings, and other complex engineering documentation
